A general term – System of Crop Intensification (SCI) – has emerged to apply to this next generation of agroecological innovation. The term usually refers to upland/unirrigated crop production , where the principles and methods from SRI are adapted and utilized to raise the productivity of land, labor, water and nutrients when cultivating other crops.

System of Rice Intensification - SRI Use in Other Crops

Crop intensification is number of crops grown grown on a particular piece pf land in a year. For example there are two main cropping seasons in north western plains. growing more than two crops during intervening period is intensification. Crop diversification is growing multiple crops in a season instead only one crop on the whole area.

The System of Rice Intensification involves cultivating rice with as much organic manure as possible, starting with young seedlings planted singly at wider spacing in a square pattern; and with intermittent irrigation that keeps the soil moist but not inundated, and frequent inter cultivation with weeder that actively aerates the soil.
